

Assistant Professor, University of Florida UF Health Family Medicine – Old Town

Dr. Jihane Naous is a Family Medicine specialist with a concentration in Adolescent and Young Adult Medicine and Health and a member of the American Academy of Family Physicians and the Society of Adolescent Health and Medicine. Medical Director - UF Health Eastside Community Practice Dr. Shaunak Mulani is a general internist by training interested in social determinants of health, preventive care, and chronic disease management. He currently serves as the Medical Director of UF Health Eastside Community Practice. Their clinic primarily serves the medically underserved community of East Gainesville. Tobacco use is prevalent in their patient population and, aside from routine counseling, Dr. Mulani and his team hope to open more innovative pathways for their patients to access smoking cessation aids.
